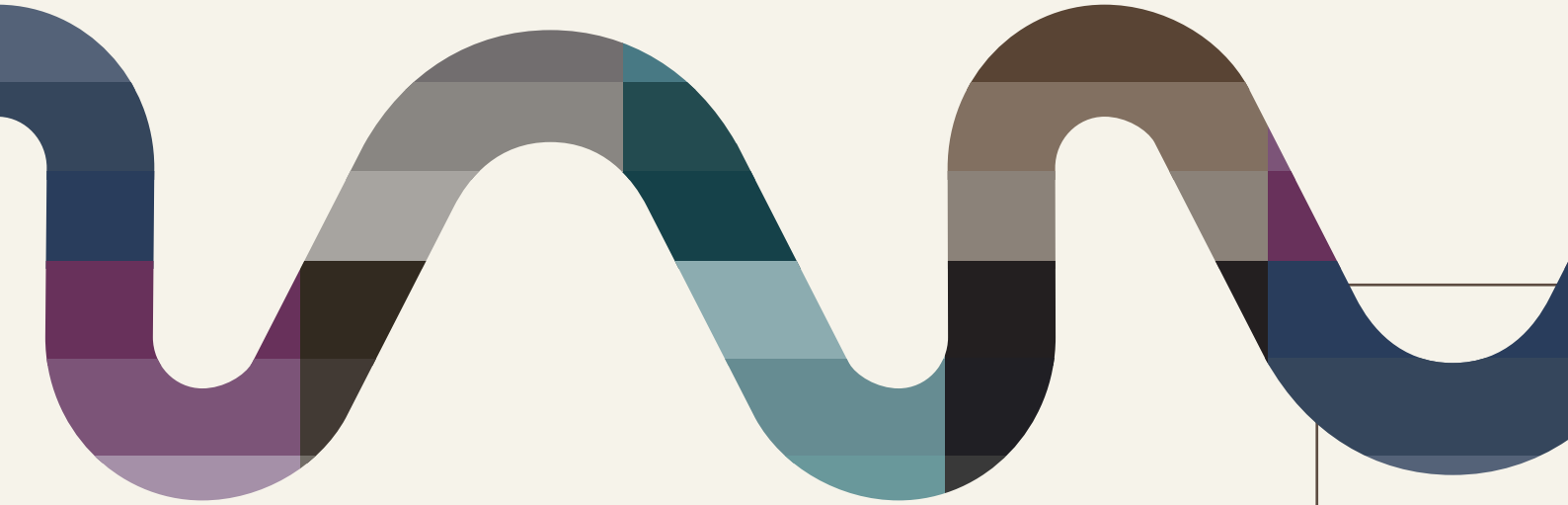

Traditional textile colour is often applied after fabric already exists. BROS approaches colour differently.

Fibres are dyed before spinning, allowing colour to move through the yarn itself rather than sitting only on the fabric surface. The result is *mélange*, heather, and tonal constructions with softness, irregularity, movement, and depth impossible to achieve through conventional surface dyeing alone.

Colour behaves differently when it is built into the yarn structure itself. It becomes:

- More layered.
- More tactile.
- More atmospheric.
- More naturally dimensional.

Combined with eqwools™ Premium Australian Merino, these yarns create a contemporary expression of wool engineered for both performance and visual richness. Not flat colour. Not static surfaces. But textile systems designed to feel alive through fibre, colour, and texture working together.

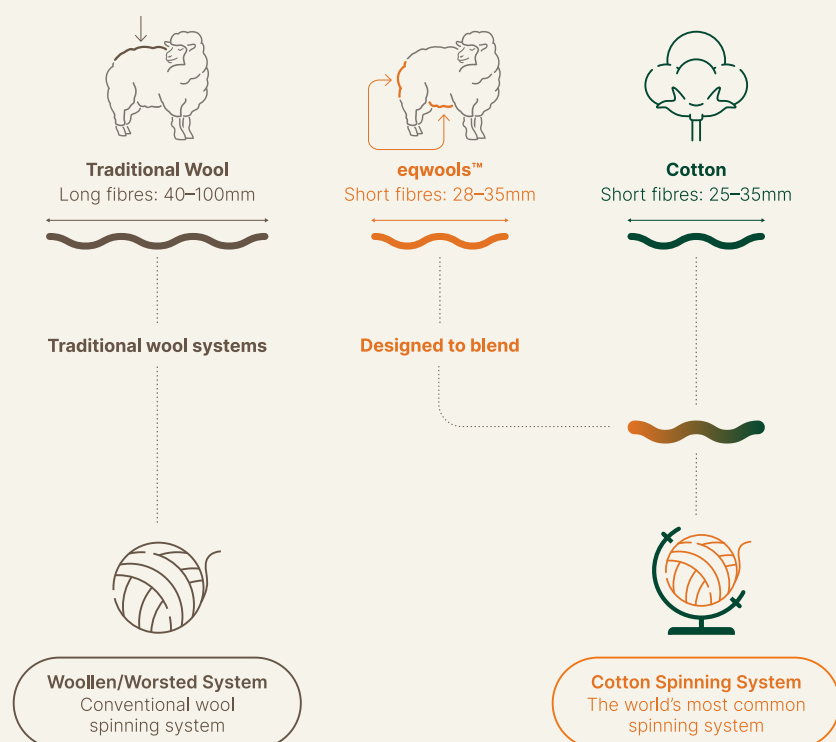

Why wool dyes beautifully

Wool is a keratin-based fibre, structurally similar to human hair. At a microscopic level, it contains a high number of active dye sites - giving merino a natural affinity for colour and depth. That's a good thing. But when wool is blended with fibres like cotton, it can also mean:

- Faster dye uptake
- Deeper, richer colour saturation
- The need for thoughtful balance across fibres

The solution isn't to limit wool - it's to understand it and work with it, unlocking all of wool's natural goodness, performance and colour potential in the blend.

Through our partnership with Deakin University ACR Research Hub for Future Fibres / Deakin's Institute for Frontier Materials, eqwools™ supports mills and manufacturers with clear, practical dyeing guidance tailored specifically for wool blends. This includes:

- Straightforward dye recipes for fibre, yarn and fabric dyeing
- Readily available dyestuffs - no specialist chemistry required
- Processing pathways designed to balance wool with companion fibres

The result: consistent colour, controlled uptake, and repeatable results - at scale.

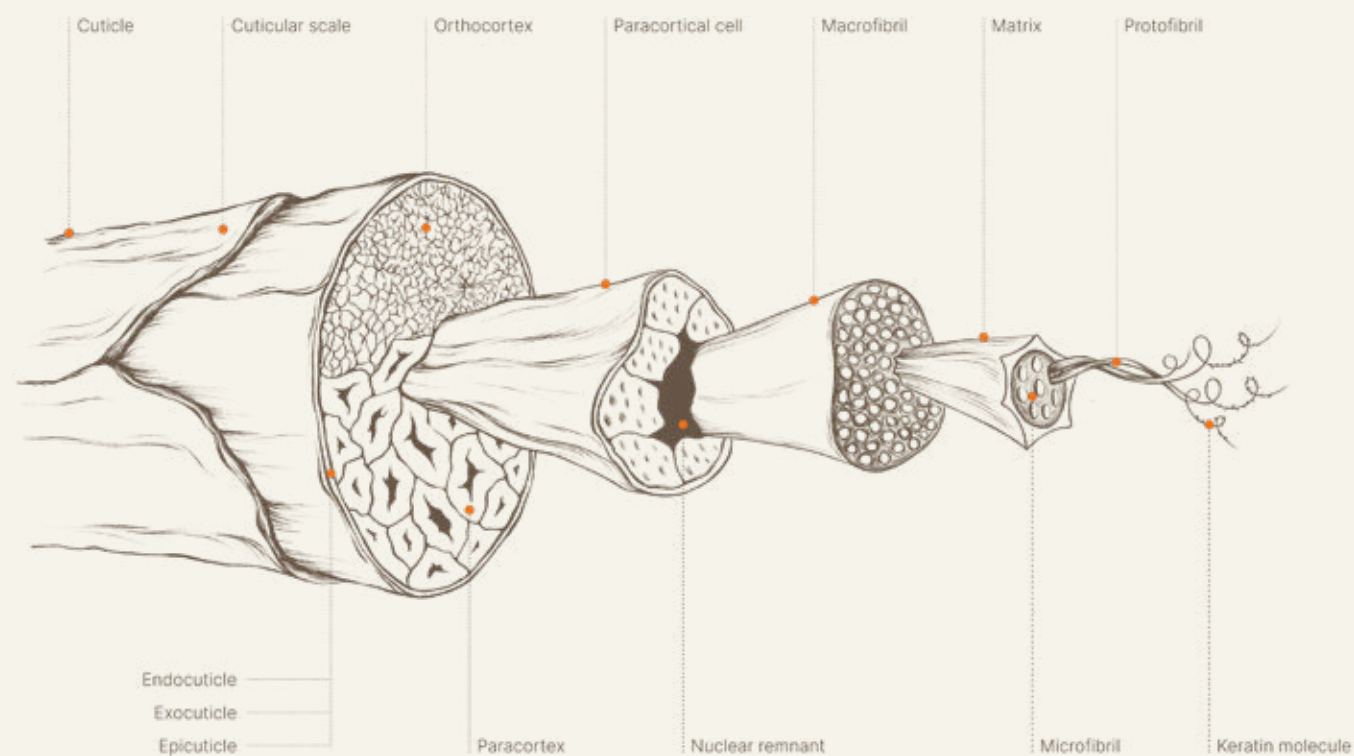

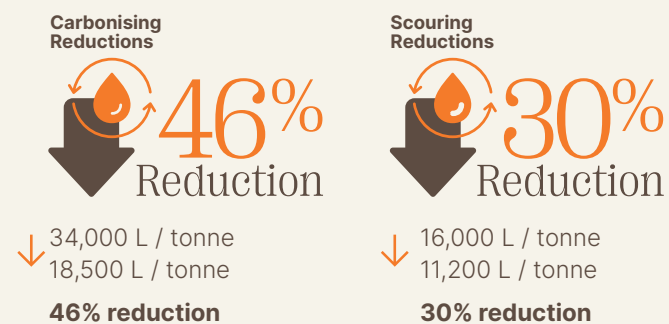

Rainwater is captured, filtered, purified, and reused throughout wool scouring processes with a relentless focus on maximising recycling and reducing waste. Using advanced filtration technology, heavily loaded wastewater is transformed into high-quality reusable scouring water.

Filtration Results

- 97% removal of suspended solids
- 91% removal of grease

What enters the system heavily loaded leaves clean, reusable, and ready to work again.

Less Water. Less Energy. More Sense.

Recycling water reduces more than water consumption alone. Less fresh water entering the system means less water requiring heating — reducing overall energy demand throughout production. For every litre cleaned and reused:

- Water consumption decreases
- Energy demand reduces
- Resource efficiency improves

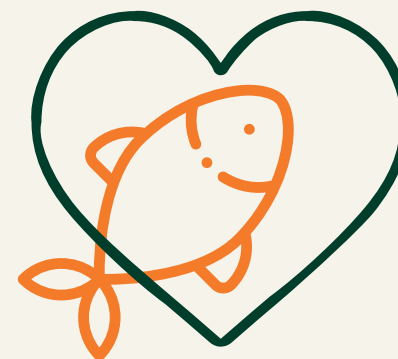

Why Apeos Don't Belong In Wool Processing



APEOs (Alkylphenol Ethoxylates) are commonly used in textile detergents and surfactants because they are highly effective during processing. The problem is what happens afterwards.

The Risks

- **Endocrine disruption**
APEOs can break down into compounds that interfere with hormone systems in humans and animals.
- **Toxicity to aquatic ecosystems**
These substances can negatively impact marine organisms and waterways.
- **Environmental persistence**
They are difficult to remove during wastewater treatment and can remain active within ecosystems.
- **Increased exposure across supply chains**
Long-term accumulation creates broader environmental and human exposure risks. Effective? Yes. Acceptable? No.
